Please note that in the UK, children under 18 are not allowed to smoke.

Global London College courses are for adults and thus any student participating in a GLC course will be treated as an adult with limited supervision. However, the welfare of all our students is extremely important to us and we ask you complete all parts of this form.

Under 18s – Letter from Parents required for all non EU/EEA/Switzerland

This information is for all students who are either visa nationals or non-visa nationals. If you are not sure of your visa status please visit: <http://www.ukvisas.gov.uk/en/>

This information does NOT apply to students from the EU/EEA/Switzerland.

All non EU/EEA/Switzerland 16 & 17 year olds will need to provide a letter from their parent or guardian with the following details.

- Their relationship with the child (eg I am Xxxxx's mother)
- Confirmation that they agree to the application
- Confirmation that they agree to the living arrangements in the UK
- Confirmation that they agree to the travel arrangements to the UK & any airport meeting or other reception service. If the child is travelling independently the letter must give consent for their independent travel to the UK & onwards to their accommodation if applicable.

The letter must confirm if the parent(s) or legal guardian has legal custody or sole responsibility for the child. If the parent/guardian has sole responsibility then they must sign the letter. If not then the letter must be signed by each parent or legal guardian.

The student should submit this letter with their visa application and have it ready to show the UK Border Authority staff at Immigration when they arrive in the UK.
